Applications are invited for filling up one post of Member (having judicial background) in State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, at Panchkula.

2. Candidates, not less than 35 years of age as on 01.01.2016 having judicial background, which means having knowledge and experience for at least a period of ten years as a Presiding Officer at the district level court or any tribunal at equivalent level and is not otherwise ineligible or disqualified as per provisions contained in Consumer Protection Act, 1986 and Haryana Consumer Protection Rules, 2004, shall be considered for appointment to the aforesaid post.

3. The candidate selected for appointment as Member(having judicial background) in State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, Panchkula shall hold office for a term of five years or upto the age of 67 years, whichever is earlier.

4. He/She shall be entitled to consolidated honorarium of Rs.40,000/- per month alongwith facilities of Government accommodation, if available or rent as per Government Rules, Rs.1000/- per month for using mobile phone or landline phone, Rs.1000/- as conveyance allowance and medical

reimbursement as per rules. He/She shall be eligible to such travelling allowance and daily allowance on official tour as are admissible to Grade I Officers of the State Govt.

5. It is made clear that the candidates who would not enclose the documents alongwith their applications, their documents will not be considered later on.

6. Only those candidates will be called for interview whose applications are found, complete in all respect, supported by requisite attested copies of documents relating to different columns of application format including the proof of income. Any application found incomplete in this regard, would be rejected in scrutiny.

7. The candidate shall despatch his/her application in such a manner that his/her application, complete in all respects reaches in the office of Secretary, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, Bay No.3-6, Sector 4, Panchkula-134112 on or before the last date of receipt of applications, that is, 11.11.2016 upto 5.00 P.M. Applications are invited for filling up 2 posts of Presidents in the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Fora in the State of Haryana from amongst following who are otherwise not ineligible or disqualified as per provisions of Consumer Protection Act,1986 and Haryana Consumer Protection Rules, 2004 and only those candidates would be eligible if they have not been dismissed from Govt. service.:-

- i) Advocates having not less than 10 years standing at Bar and are not less than 35 years of age as on 01.01.2016.
 - ii) Serving District/Addl. District Judges; and
 - iii) Retired District/Addl. District Judges
 - iv) Serving/Retired District Attorney/Deputy District Attorney/ Assistant District Attorney.
2. The candidates selected for appointment as President of the District Forum shall hold office for a term of five years or upto the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.
3. The pay scale of incumbents of the post shall be Rs.57700-1230-58130-1380-67210-1540-70290. In case of serving Judicial Officers they will be paid salary in the pay scale of their parent department plus Rs.100/- as deputation allowance whereas in case of retired Judicial Officers/Govt. officers possessing requisite qualifications and experience, the emoluments will be determined as per Rule 52 Chapter 11 of Haryana Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 2016. Other detailed terms and conditions shall be determined by the Govt. later on.
4. Only those candidates shall be considered who have been paying income tax on professional income for atleast 3 years immediately prior to the date of application. Further, professional income for atleast one year during this period must be Rs.5 lacs or more. The

candidates shall annexe the attested/certified copies of income tax returns alongwith their applications failing which their applications will be liable to be rejected out-rightly

5. Incomplete applications or applications not supported by requisite attested copies of documents related to different columns of application form will be liable to be rejected out-rightly without assigning any reason for the same and the candidates will not be called for interview.

6. Applications complete in all respects must reach the office of Secretary, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, Bay No.3-6, Sector 4, Panchkula-134112 latest by 11.11.2016 upto 5.00 P.M. It is made clear that the candidates must apply on the format given below failing which their application will not be entertained.
