

Procedure for Brick Kiln License and Fee-Structure

BRICK KILN

1- How to get the new licence of manufacture, sell or supply bricks?

The services of issuing a Brick Kiln Licence is now providing online through Single Window System(HEPC) <https://investharyana.in/#/>.

The services of a Brick Kiln Licence is also notified vide notification dated 02-12-2016 under Haryana Right to Service Act-2014.

All applications for the grant of licence shall be made to the District Level Committee(DLCC) and State Level Committee(EEC) through online application i.e. Common Application Form(CAF).

2- Where a Brick Kiln can be established?

The site fulfills the conditions of distance parameters mentioned as per Clause 4 and other related clauses of "The Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order 1972" (Accept Controlled Area and Urbanizable Zones declared by the government and also with in 2 Kilometers belt around the Urbanizable Zones in Class 1 cities and I Kilometer in other towns).

- Required documents for New Brick Kiln License:- If the site is in controlled area then Licence of controlled area otherwise NOC from Town and Country Planning Department, Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate from Pollution Control Board, Permit from Mines & Geology Department, GST No from Sale tax department, NDC reg. Reserve forest from Forest Department & NOC reg. 220KV line from Electricity Department.
- Requirement For Renewal of Brick Kiln License:- If the site is in controlled area then Licence of controlled area from Town and Country Planning Department, Consent from Pollution Control Board, Permit from Mines & Geology Department, Receipt of the payment of sale tax alongwith NDC from Sale tax department.

3- Fees of Licence?

A fee of Rs. 2000.00 per year shall be payable to the Government for a licence granted under the Control Order 1972. The licence may be granted up to five years at any time, subject to the conditions fulfillment of documents from other concerned departments/Board.

The licence shall be renewable for a period of one year to five years on application by the licensee to the District Magistrate on the payment of a fee at the rate of Rs.2000.00 per year, subject to the conditions fulfillment of documents from other concerned departments/Board.

Every manufacturer shall deposit security of Rs. 5000.00 with the Licensing Authority for due fulfillment of the terms and conditions of the Control Order 1972 in the forms of N.S.C etc. dully pledged to the licensing Authority.

An Application regarding relaxation in Distances parameter can be made to The State Government under clause 21 of "The Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order 1972".
