

LICENSING AND REGULATION OF BRICK KILNS

- The Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order, 1972 is made under section 3 of the East Punjab Control of Bricks supplies Act, 1949.
- Distance norms for setting up of new brick kiln:

Village Abadi*	School/Dispensary & Hospital, other educational public utility institution & Parks *	Garden/ Nursery & Reserve Forests**	Municipal Limits *
800 meters*	1 KM each*	1 KM each**	3 KMs (A)*, 2 KMs(B)* & 800 meters(C)*

➤ The State Govt. can give relaxation in the above setting parameters as indicated below :-

* maximum 20%

** maximum 10%

*** no relaxation can be given

➤ Number of Brick Kilns in the State (March, 2018): 2752

➤ Clause 9, 10, 12 to 16 and relevant forms 'c' to 'f' are omitted from The Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order, 1972 vide notification dated 1.3.2007. These clauses relate to permit for purchase of bricks, fixation of prices of bricks, inspection of brick kiln premises and any vehicle which is used for carrier of bricks, maintenance of registers of selling and manufacturing of bricks.

➤ Required documents for New Brick Kiln License:- If the site is in controlled area then Licence of controlled area otherwise NOC from Town and Country Planning Department, Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate from Pollution Control Board, Permit from Mines & Geology Department, GST No from Sale tax department, NDC reg. Reserve forest from Forest Department & NOC reg. 220KV line from Electricity Department.

➤ Requirement For Renewal of Brick Kiln License:- If the site is in controlled area then Licence of controlled area from Town and Country Planning Department, Consent from Pollution Control Board, Permit from Mines & Geology Department, Receipt of the payment of sale tax alongwith NDC from Sale tax department.

➤ Security of Brick Kiln License Rs. 5000/- and License/Renewal Fee Rs. 2000/- per year.
